Nadar Saraswathi College of Arts and Science was established in the year 1996 by Theni Melapettai Hindu Nadargal Uravinmurai Educational Society to promote higher education among the rural poor.

Theni Melapettai Hindu Nadargal Uravinmurai has a history of over a century of offering social welfare and educational services to the poor and needy in Theni District.

The trust started Nadar Saraswathi Primary School in the year 1919 with the object of starting the Institutions to supplement Government's efforts to provide valuable education to the economically as well as educationally backward people. At present 11 educational institutions offers education from preprimary level to higher education in the field of arts and science, technical and engineering is the pride of the Uravinmurai. The Uravinmurai limited itself till 1996, to providing school level education for people in and



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around Theni. But today, in a totally changed socio-economic scenario after globalization, sensing people's needs and aspirations, the trust has ventured into providing university education to the marginalized poor.
