### **PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE**

Nadar Saraswathi College of Arts and Science was established in the year 1996 by Theni Melapettai Hindu Nadargal Uravinmurai Educational Society to promote higher education among the rural people.

Theni Melapettai Hindu Nadargal Uravinmurai has a history of over a century, offering social welfare and educational services to the poor and needy in Theni District.



The trust started Nadar Saraswathi Primary School in the year 1919 with the objective of building an educated society with the Government's efforts to provide valuable education to the economically as well as educationally backward people. At present 14 educational institutions offer education from preprimary level to higher education level in the field of arts and science, technical and engineering which stands as the pride of the Uravinmurai. The Uravinmurai limited itself till 1996, by providing school level education for people in and around Theni. But today, in a totally changed socio-economic scenario after globalization, sensing people's needs and aspirations, the trust has ventured into providing university education to the marginalized poor.

The total numbers of beneficiaries of student community are around 25,000 per year. Our Institution plays an important role not only in the development of individuals but also in the development of the society.

At this juncture I bow before the grand generous members who founded the college. It is the philanthropy of those members that has made our College - a seat of social reform movements, cultural renaissance, intellectual awakening for the young women of this rural setup.
